

wordwise – 10 easy steps for registering a new account

1. Go to www.wordwise.uni-jena.de
2. On the left-hand side, click on "Create new account".
3. Provide a unique username.
4. Enter a password that you can remember. Write it down and store it in a safe place.
5. Enter an e-mail address that you **regularly** check. This is one of the most important things to keep in mind. News, forum posts, and various other pieces of information will be sent to this address. It is important that you actually receive these messages. Use an account that has enough space in your inbox in order to avoid problems with receiving notifications. Accounts with very limited server space (e.g. web.de) should **not** be used.
6. Fill in the remaining required information.
7. CAPTCHA is a security mechanism that is employed on wordwise in order to avoid it getting spammed with dummy user accounts. Please enter the words you will see into the box (separated by a space). Should you not be able to read what is provided, you can generate a new pair of words by clicking on the button "Get another CAPTCHA".
8. Click "Create my new account" and then check the e-mail address you entered. You should find a confirmation link in an e-mail. Click on this link to confirm your registration. If you don't receive the confirmation e-mail, be sure to check your spam folder. Contact your teacher if there is any problem with your registration.
9. Back at wordwise, navigate through the course list to the course(s) you would like to enroll in. By clicking on a course for the first time, you will be asked for your enrollment key. Carefully enter in the key your instructor will have given you. You will only need to do this once. In the future you'll only need to login on the site's homepage, and you'll see a list of the courses you are enrolled in on the right-hand side of the page.
10. After gaining access to your course(s), take a minute to update your profile. You can add more personal information, upload a picture, etc. Have a look around at your courses and, where applicable, check for homework assignments and download course materials.
